

Cadastre 2026: Renewed, Re-imagined, Recommitted and Relevant?

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SUMMARY

In 2023, after a period of turbulence and uncertainty brought on by the global pandemic, the international land administration community - through FIG Commission 7 - set out a plan to renew, re-imagine, and recommit to global advocacy, networking, and knowledge creation in cadastre and land management. This paper reflects on that plan: what was achieved, what worked, what did not, and what may come next. It reviews the outcomes of key events held during the period, highlights publications produced and in progress, and considers the role the global land administration community can play in the decade ahead.
